Suggested Tours of the Glen Burnie Gardens

The Museum's gardens include six acres of beautiful formal gardens that were once the Wood family homestead. Gardens are open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Sunday, March 1 through November 31 (closed Monday).

Can You Find This? (Grades K – 12)

This fun outdoor scavenger hunt activity takes students through the six-acre Glen Burnie Gardens. This activity can be self- or staff-guided as requested.
