Touring the Glen Burnie Historic House

The house is open from 10:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Tuesday through Sunday, March 1 through November 31 (closed Monday).

Staff-guided tours highlight the history of the Wood family homestead is offered to students in **7th grade or above. The tour is not designed for younger students.** The house tour features eighteenth- and nineteenth-century fine art and furniture collected by Julian Wood Glass Jr. (1910-1992), a direct descendant of Colonel James Wood the founder of Winchester, Virginia. Tours of the historic house are especially good for students interested in interior design, furniture designs, fine art, Colonial Revival, or architecture. House tours are approximately 30 minutes long and can accommodate ten visitors each. Special arrangements can be made for groups of 25 or more who request a tour of the historic house—in advance—.
